Tick	1.	Risk Assessment
	a.	Risk assessment system(s) in place
	b.	Census data demonstrating the organisation has met or exceeded 95% risk assessment within 14h of decision to admit consistently
	2.	Thromboprophylaxis
	a.	At least quarterly audit of % patients receiving appropriate thromboprophylaxis within 14 hours of admission to hospital. (Minimum 100 patients or 10% of inpatient hospital admissions, whichever is lowest.)
	3.	VTE prevention PSIRF Work
	a.	Presentation of the process and staff involved, protocol and examples of action plans
	b.	Identification of potentially preventable cases of hospital associated venous thrombosis and evidence of application of duty of candour as appropriate
	4.	Patient Information
	a.	Have a written information leaflet on VTE prevention available for all patients admitted to hospital
	b.	VTE explained verbally to patients by appropriate members of staff
	c.	At least annual audit of % patients receiving written information. (Minimum 100 patients or 10% of inpatient hospital admissions, whichever is lowest.)
	5.	Displaying the Qualities of an Exemplar Centre
	a.	Please provide examples of how your organisation is disseminating best practice in VTE prevention and displaying a culture of continuous improvement (e.g. hosting visitors, study days, working with non-exemplar centres, contributing to the VSN , publications etc.)
	b.	Active involvement in the VTE Exemplar Centres Buddy System or willingness to participate
	6.	Education
	a.	Evidence of an ongoing organisation wide VTE education programme for all clinical staff on induction and at regular intervals
	7.	Staff
	a.	Named VTE prevention lead in post (full/part time)
